**MONSIGNOR ROBERT J. DEMPSEY,
M.A., S.T.D.**

Msgr. Robert J. Dempsey was born and raised in Chicago. He holds A.B.Clas. and M.A. degrees in philosophy from Loyola University of Chicago, an S.T.B. from the Pontifical Gregorian University, an S.T.L. from the University of St. Mary of the Lake, and an S.T.D. from the Pontifical University of the Holy Cross (Rome). Ordained a priest by Pope John Paul II in 1980, he worked as an associate pastor in three parishes while serving part-time as a notary and field advocate of the Metropolitan Tribunal, member of the Archdiocesan Catholic-Greek Orthodox Dialogue Commission, and master of ceremonies to Cardinal Bernardin. From 1991 to 2001 he was editor of the weekly English edition of *L'Osservatore Romano*, the Vatican's newspaper, and he served as pastor of St. Philip the Apostle Parish in Northfield from 2003 to 2017. He is currently pastor of St. Patrick's Parish in Lake Forest and is a member of the Archdiocesan Bioethics Commission and the Priests' Advisory Committee of the Respect Life Office. He also serves as visiting lecturer at the Liturgical Institute of the University of St. Mary of the Lake in Mundelein and as magistral chaplain of the Order of Malta for the Illinois region.

Msgr. Dempsey is the spiritual advisor to WSFI 88.5 FM Catholic Radio from the Archdiocese of Chicago.
